GENERAL


- More and more need for PT is blooming as a result of requirements from accreditation and administration, and also from the strengthening quality awareness of the labs.
- In order to meet the needs above, CNAS has
 - developed a series of policy on PT;
 - made great efforts in various works, including organization of PT schemes, reinforcement of measurement audits, etc;
 - built up the accreditation program for PT providers at the 2000 and provides the accreditation service;
 - promotes the PT to CABs in our country continuously for increasing their quality assurance level.

NEEDS

- Accompanied by increasing attention to testing results, more and more laboratory seek the accreditation. The need for accreditation brings the need for PT.
- More and more ministries require labs to participate in PT as an important supervision tool. Such regulatory requirements further incent the need for PT.
- The increasing attention on the testing results rouses the awareness of labs and IBs, to enhance the quality themselves. The awaken awareness also forms the great need for PT.


Current status of CNAS accreditation

Distribution chart of different types of bodies accredited by CNAS (as to 31 Mar, 2011)




How many laboratories in China?

Needs from Administrations

- CNAS has run the PT schemes in cooperation with ministries and associations to assist their administration.
 - Ministries:
 - Public Security (in forensic)
 - Justice (forensic)
 - Industry & Informatization (IT)
 - Agriculture (manure, feeds, foods, tobacco)
 - AQSIQ (tests, quarantine, inspections, calibrations)
 - National associations:
 - Mechanics, petroleum, light industry, textile, etc.

MARKET

- Confronted the PT needs as above, the resources of PT providers become a new unavoidable problem, CNAS has launched much study, and formulated policies with opening minds, to meet the PT needs of laboratories and inspecting bodies.
- Although government has played the key role in the boost of PT needs, however, as an accreditation body, CNAS has defined the PT as a marketing activity, and tried the best to coordinate the relation

between regulating body.

Big needs could create a big market

POLICIES

- Under the pre-condition of meeting to international requirements and taking consideration of the needs from labs and inspection bodies, CNAS developed its own policy on PT. In this way, the policy formed the requirements to applicants and accredited CABs.
- Meanwhile, some ministries and the industrial associations put forward their own requirements on PT.

Status quo on PT policy

- CNAS RL02: Rule of PT
 - Requirements for organizing and running the PT;
 - Requirements for participating PT (Al07);
 - Policy on recognition of outside PT (AL08);
- CNAS Al07: Sub-area and Frequency of PT
- CNAS AL08:Requirements and list of application material for seeking recognition from CNAS
- CNAS RL06: Rule of Accreditation for PTP
- CNAS CL03: criteria of Accreditation for PTP
- Inner procedures and working instructions

Problems and Challenge in the PT and PTP Accreditation

- The provision of PT is still insufficient to needs;
- PTPs need to realize the professional and occupational;
- Poor experts and assessor, lacking of experience on PT, affect the quality of PT schemes;
- consciousness of labs for participating in PT needs to promote.

CONCLUSION

- There are many new methods of PT need to be studied in the future, in order to improve the development of PT, to make full use of quality assurance from PT, and to meet the needs from CABs and other stakeholders.
- It is a long way for us to realize them gradually. The widely exchange and cooperation are very important.
